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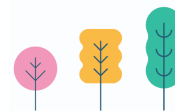

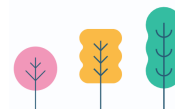
First ever Japanese immersion preschool opens in Victoria

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Craigflower Schoolhouse



- Constructed in 1854, it is the oldest surviving school building in Western Canada.
- It was designated a national historic site of Canada in 1964 and is maintained as a BC Heritage Site.

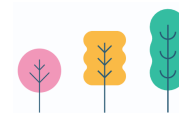
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Philosophy

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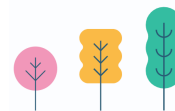
Requirements



PROGRAM		REQUIREMENTS
Full Day	4-5days /week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students are expected to follow “Japanese Only Policy”. A family member is willing to learn Japanese along with student.
	3-2 days /week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students are expected to follow “Japanese Only Policy”. Students are expected to have Japanese language experience at entry. At least one of family members can support the student for Japanese communication at home.
Half-Day		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The minimum attendance days per week would vary from child to child depending on their Japanese comprehension.

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Priority Order for Registration



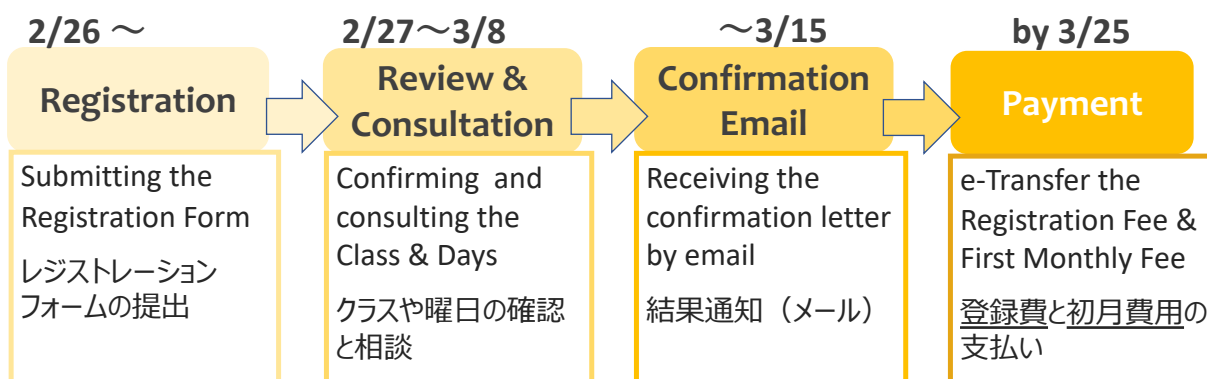
Full-Day Student
